PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

FIRST AID

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BACK FIELD™ is an excellent sticker, which enhances the adhesion and duration of applied pesticide spray solutions. By bonding active ingredients to the plant surfaces, **BACK FIELD™** facilitates maximum efficacy of pest control applications and provides some wash off protection against rainfall and irrigation.

Ideal For:

- Increasing the efficacy of pesticide spray operations
- Extending the duration of fungicide control, especially under adverse weather conditions
- Improving the rainfastness of pesticide applications

DIRECTIONS FOR USE NOT FOR AQUATIC USE

NOTICE: Pesticide manufacturers routinely detail adjuvant use guidelines on the pesticide label and should be followed. The use, mixing and dosage guidelines on this label are not intended to supersede or displace pesticide label instructions and should only be used as general use recommendations when or if pesticide labels do not provide specific instructions.

Apply solutions containing **BACK FIELD**^m a minimum of one hour before expected rainfall. Sunlight is required during this time to bond the pesticides to the target.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

As with all spray applications, be certain the spray tank is clean and free from previous spray solutions using a tank cleaner such as **ONSIDE KICK™**. Always follow the instructions on the pesticide label. If the label lacks specific mixing instructions, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

1.) Fill tank ½ full of water and initiate tank agitation systems. If foaming is anticipated, add an antifoam agent such as **REVERSE**TM.

2.) Add pesticide/nutritional actives as directed by those respective label(s). Continue agitation.

3.) Add the required dosage of **BACK FIELD™** (refer to the dose chart below).

4.) Continue filling tank with remaining water and maintain agitation throughout the spray process.
