#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### FIRST AID

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

**WIDEOUT** is a surfactant based on organo-modified siloxane technology for use in water-based pesticide formulations.

**WIDEOUT** is a highly effective nonionic wetter, spreader, penetrant and readily biodegradable surfactant.

**WIDEOUT** effectiveness may allow the use of the lowest labeled pesticide rate at the lowest recommended surfactant level.

Careful observation of spray application is recommended to determine proper and efficient pesticide application. This will optimize the pesticide and surfactant load levels. Read warning and precautionary statements carefully before use.

While **WIDEOUT** has been proven to be a highly efficient surfactant; timing, weather conditions and methods of application, crop conditions, and/or mixture with other chemicals not specifically recommended are beyond the control of the seller. Therefore, the user should carefully observe spray deposits, rate efficiencies, compatibilities and effectiveness in initial application and adjust the adjuvant rates accordingly.

**WIDEOUT** enhances permeation through wetting resistant surfaces and rapid penetration to the mode of action site.

Low foaming and compatible with most active ingredients in all crop and non-crop applications when the active ingredient label permits or does not exclude an organosilicone (OSS) surfactant.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Pesticide manufacturers may recommend a rate of a nonionic surfactant to be used with their product. Follow the pesticide or active ingredient label recommendations on the use of nonionic surfactants. However, if the pesticide or active ingredient label does not prohibit the use of a nonionic surfactant, **WIDEOUT** should be applied at the rates listed below.

Careful observation of spray performance in a trial application with the combinations of chemicals to be applied is recommended to determine proper and efficient surfactant rates.

If the user does not have experience with the mixture being applied, perform a jar test using the order and amounts in the mixture and perform a phytotoxicity test to ensure crop safety.

#### AS A SPRAY ADJUVANT FOR PESTICIDES

Application	WIDEOUT per 100 gal of spray solution
HERBICIDES	6-13 ounces
DEFOLIANTS	6-13 ounces
MICRO-NUTRIENTS	4-8 ounces
INSECTICIDES	4-8 ounces
FUNGICIDES	4-8 ounces
AERIAL APPLICATIONS	12-16 ounces

## AS A SOIL WETTING AGENT: GOLF COURSE TEES AND GREENS

Apply a concentration of 0.1% v/v or use the Spray Rate Chart below

Spray Rate/ 1000 sq. ft	Amount of WIDEOUT in mix
1.0 gallon	1/8 ounce
1.5 gallon	1/5 ounce
2.0 gallon	1/4 ounce

Repeat as needed to overcome hydrophobic soil conditions. Irrigation is not needed but will help incorporate the treatment into the soil.

#### FOR LARGE AREAS OF APPLICATION:

Apply at a rate of 1-2 ounces per acre. Typically applied in 10-20 gallons of water per acre.

Apply weekly applications or as part of a maintenance program to overcome hydrophobic soil conditions and localized dry spots.

### IMPORTANT: ADDITIONAL OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHEMIGATION

Review your state and local regulatory requirements before applying any adjuvant of agricultural chemical through an irrigation system. Refer to the SUPPLEMENTAL LABELING FOR CHEMIGATION APPLICATIONS for additional use requirements and restrictions.

#### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

- Fill tank to 2/3 to 3/4 full of water. If foaming is anticipated, add an anti-foaming agent before pesticide and WIDEOUT.
- Add pesticide as directed by pesticide label.
- Continue agitations.
- Add WIDEOUT and continue filling tank while maintaining agitation.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep container tightly closed. Store in original container only. Keep in a secure and locked storage area. Do not add water to the contents of this container. Triple rinse container, empty rinse water into the spray tank. Dispose of the empty container in accordance with federal, state and local law
