## Soil Wetting Agent

Power Run is a premier EO/PO block co-polymer wetting agent. It is highly effective for reducing localized dry spot and improving soil moisture uniformity on high-value turf areas like golf course putting greens, tees, fairways, and athletic fields.

### IDEAL FOR

Power Run is ideal for use on high-value turf areas like golf course putting greens, tees, fairways, and athletic fields.

### HOW IT WORKS

Power Run uses a blend of surfactants and EO/PO block copolymers to reduce water surface tension and reduce soil hydrophobicity. The product binds with organic coatings on soil particles, reducing their hydrophobic nature and improving wetting and soil moisture uniformity. Power Run will help your turf look better while using less water.

### HOW TO USE

Power Run treatments may be made approximately once a month.

The first treatment is made at a high use rate to properly surround the water repellent soil or thatch layers with surfactant.

Treatments that follow replace the surfactant lost over time due to normal degradation and biological activity under average field conditions.

Treatments should start prior to or when signs of stress such as yellowing, curling leaves begin to show or as water is observed pooling on the surface.

### QUALITY ASSURANCE

*Exacto products are manufactured with pride at our production facility in Sharon, Wisconsin. Each batch is inspected by our Quality Assurance Team to ensure it meets our high standards.*

The solution may be applied via an in-ground irrigation system, through a spray bar on a tractor, or via hand-held sprayers.

Power Run may be applied to bare ground, stressed or green plants as long as adequate water, is used in the application.

Power Run is a soil moisture management product that **MUST** make soil contact to be effective.

Watering after application is not required when applied by injection irrigation.

If not applied by an irrigation system, follow the treatment with at least ¼ inch of water.

If grass cutting is performed prior to irrigation or rain, do not remove clippings as much of the product may still be on the leaves.

### RECOMMENDED USE RATE

**First application:** 8 to 16 ounces of Power Run mixed in a minimum of 2 gallons of water for every 1000 square feet of turf or soil that will be treated.

**Second, third, fourth, etc. application:** If symptoms have not reappeared, 4 to 8 ounces of Power Run in a minimum of 2 gallons of water for every 1000 square feet of turf or soil that will be treated.
