PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONING AGENTS: (BY WEIGHT)

Light Paraffinic Petroleum Distillates, Tall Oil Fatty Acid, Alkylphenol Ethoxylate	99.0%
Constituents ineffective as a spray adjuvant	1.0%

This product cannot be used for aquatic applications.

FIRST AID

Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

GENERAL INFORMATION

INLAY™ is a nonionic blend of surfactants, and highly refined phytybland paraffin oil. It is designed for use with a broad range of pesticides, where an oil concentrate adjuvant is recommended.

INLAY increases contact activity and penetration of the spray, while also providing uniform coverage on leaf surfaces.

Always follow herbicide label recommendations.

RECOMMENDED RATES

Ground, Aerial, Low Volume, CDA: Use 1 to 2 pints to the acre or 1 gallon per 100 (1.00% v/v)

Rates may vary depending on the recommendation of the pesticide label. Follow the directions and use rate recommended on the pesticide label.

MIXING

To prepare for pesticide application, fill spray tank one-half full with water and begin agitation. Add pesticide or fertilizer as recommended, and then add **INLAY** while continuing agitation. Continue to agitate until tank is full and agitate before and during each application.

NOTE: The effect of any adjuvant on a chemicals performance is not predictable under all conditions of weather, plant vigor, application methods, and even water types. The user should consult his local agricultural extension agent, or make his own tests, to determine the optimum level of **INLAY** for special pesticide spray and crop.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool dry place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. If frozen, warm container and shake well before using. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program. To contact your state and local ACRC recycler visit the ACRC web page at www.acrecycle.org.

NOTE: Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water sources by run-off from cleaning of equipment, disposal of rinse waters or spray mixtures.
