FIRST AID

GENERAL INFORMATION

Wishbone™ is formulated with soil wetting agents to rapidly reduce wetting resistance associated with localized dry spots (LDS) and environmental stress in turf environments.

Wishbone penetrates hydrophobic soil layers almost immediately and facilitates the permeation of critical moisture into the root zone

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOT FOR AQUATIC USE

Refer to the label recommendations of every product used if applying a mixture.

DO NOT PRE-MIX with pesticides, nutrients or other adjuvants before mixing with water.

If the user does not have experience with the product or mixture being applied, he should perform a jar test using the order and amounts in the proposed mixture and conduct a phytotoxicity test to ensure plant safety and to determine mixture compatibility.

Caution should be used when applying this or any other product on turf during hot, dry conditions.

USE RATES

GREENS/TEES/FAIRWAYS AND ATHLETIC FIELDS

Initial treatment: 8 ounces of **Wishbone** in at least 1 gallon of water per 1000 sq. Ft.

A supplementary dose may be applied: 4-8 ounces in at least 1 gallon water per 1000 sq. Ft. Weekly as needed.

Topdressing applications: 4-8 ounces in at least 1 gallon water per 1000 sq. Ft. Weekly as needed.

GENERAL TURF

Initial treatment: 8 ounces of **Wishbone** in at least 1 gallon of water per 1000 sq. ft.

Supplementary doses may be applied: 4-8 ounces in at least 1 gallon water per 1000 sq. ft. weekly until the problem is alleviated. Continue to use monthly throughout the season as needed.

SOD INSTALLATIONS

After laying sod, apply 8 ounces of **Wishbone** in at least 2 gallons of water per 1000 sq. ft.

Depending on environmental conditions, an experienced applicator may choose not to water in **Wishbone** immediately after application. Irrigate before the next mowing or leave baskets off.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not add anything to the container. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not store near fire, flame or other potential sources of ignition. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product. STORE BETWEEN 40° AND 90° F.

Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents in container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all federal, state and local regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to application tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by local regulations.
